

Vote “YES” on the Three Amendments to the Virginia Constitution

**Reproductive
Freedom**

This would prohibit the state from prosecuting a mother who receives prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, birth control, abortion, miscarriage management, or fertility care. It would also protect health care workers who aid in such care.

YES
**Marriage
Equality**

This would allow the Virginia Constitution to align with the current federal law, allowing two adults to marry regardless of gender, sex or race.

YES
**Voting
Rights**

This would provide the fundamental right to vote in the Commonwealth, including restoring the right to vote to former felons upon release from incarceration. (During incarceration felons will still be prohibited from voting.)



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
